**bokor architecture + interiors** were engaged in 2015 to establish the new base building standards in collaboration with Synergy Projects following the successful refurbishment of Level 1.

Prior to re-leasing Level 7, **bokor** were once again given the opportunity to design to the same calibre as the Level 1 refurbishment. The brief called for Level 7 to act as the display suite for leasing opportunities on other floors following it's rebranding as a premium, boutique, commercial building.

**bokor's** design uses the same base building layout and finishes throughout for lift lobbies and amenities with meeting rooms, reception areas and breakout spaces having individual identities on each floor. Meeting rooms were designed with full height glazing and natural white sheer curtains for screening. Waiting areas are defined with continuous floor and wall parquetry to provide a seamless feature. The reception has a unique marble inspired reception desk which acts as a dramatic complement to the neutral finishes.

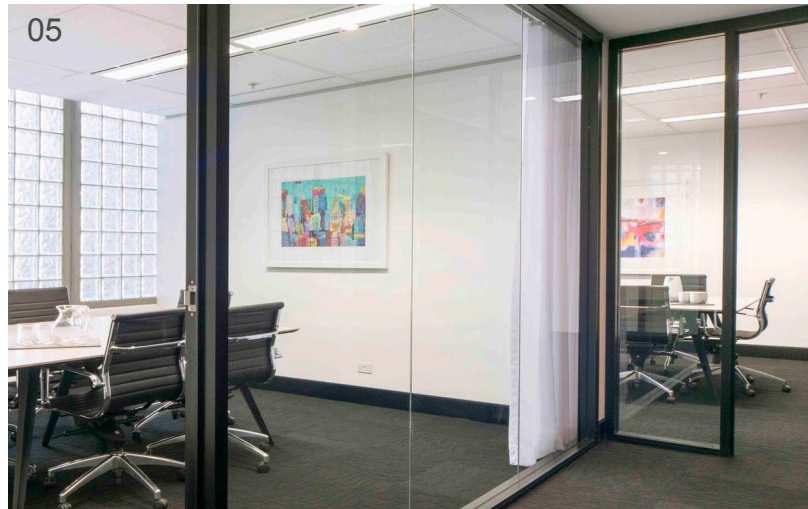
